The Morton Simmonds Scholarship Society is pleased to announce the prestigious Morton Simmonds Educational Scholarship Program for the Correctional Worker's program at the Nova Scotia Community College.

Sponsored by the Nova Scotia Department of Justice, this prominent scholarship is awarded annually in honor of Mr. Morton Simmonds, the first African Nova Scotian Correctional Officer in Atlantic Canada. The total value of the scholarship includes all tuition costs and textbooks for the duration. Additionally, the successful applicant will be offered employment with the Department of Justice upon completion of the program and following a signed commitment agreement for two years service at the Provincial Correctional Facility.

In partnership with the Nova Scotia Community College, the North Preston Gospel Technology Association, and the Watershed Association Development Enterprise, the Morton Simmonds Scholarship Committee is pleased to accept applications from members of the African Nova Scotian Community and First Nations Community who meet the following criteria:

- **19 years of age or older (proof of age required)**
- **Applicants must hold a high school diploma or GED Certificate**
- **NSCC Human Service course or University degree**
- **Be accepted by NSCC (Correction Officer Program)**
- **All potential candidates shall meet all requirements for employment and student placement at a Provincial Correctional Services Facility prior to being accepted.**

Scholarship Must Be Accompanied by:

- 1. Resume**
- 2. A current Criminal Record Check and Child Abuse Registry Check.**
- 3. 500-word essay explaining your interest in becoming a Corrections Officer.**
- 4. Official High School and/or University Transcripts from schools attended**
- 5. Three letters of reference: Two (2) academic references and one (1) personal**
