APPLICATION FORM

QUALIFICATIONS AND REGULATIONS

<u>-</u>

- Scholarships are open to applicants who are practicing Catholics of good moral character, who are residents of Nova Scotia, who have completed Nova Scotia Grade XII or attending first year University, College, or Community College beyond the secondary level and who are in need of financial assistance.
- Other things being equal, preference will be given to members of the Knights of Columbus in good standing, their sons, their daughters, brothers, sisters, wives and grandchildren. This preference will also extend to applicants so related to deceased members who were in good standing at the time of death.

- Scholarships are awarded on a competitive basis and on high academic standing. The Committee, at its own discretion, may require an examination for any and all applicants.
- Scholarships are tenable at any legally recognized and State Council approved University, College, or Community College beyond the secondary level.
- Non renewable scholarships are awarded annually valued at \$1,000 each to successful applicants undertaking undergraduate studies at a post secondary educational institution.

- Scholarship payments are mailed out by the end of January each year. Cheques are made out jointly to the recipients and the University/College concerned
- The NS State Council of the Knights of Columbus reserves the right to abandon or modify the scholarship program in the event of circumstances the nature of which would render the continuance of the program impractical.



APPLICATION PROCEDURES

Application forms and further information may be obtained from the State Scholarship Representative or other officials of the local Knights of Columbus Councils nearest the homes of the applicants.

The completed application forms and the required documents must be returned to the Council Scholarship Representative by March 9, 2018.

Along with the completed application forms, applicants must present the appropriate documents as follows:

- At least one (1) letter of reference from an appropriate school official
- II. An Official Transcript as follows:
- a. For students currently attending Grade XII: an <u>official transcript</u> of Grade XI final marks and the Grade XII midterm/first semester marks.
- b. For students currently attending first year
 University, College, or Community College: an
 <u>official transcript</u> of all High School final marks,
 and an <u>official transcript</u> of the University,
 College, or Community College midterm marks.
- III. A letter of reference from their Parish Priest.
- IV. A letter outlining work experience related to Church, School and Community Activities.
- Covering letter in support of applicant. <u>Prepared</u>
 <u>by submitting Knights of Columbus Council.</u>
