CONDITIONS OF BURSARY:

- Value of Bursary - \$2250
- One Bursary will be awarded annually as an entrance scholarship to a student entering University of Community College directly from High School.
- Applicants must be a Canadian Citizen and resident of Colchester County, Nova Scotia.
- Applicants must be seeking admission to a degree granting University or Community College in one of the four Atlantic Provinces.

ELIGIBILITY FOR BURSARY:

- Applicant must be intending to undertake full time, first year studies.
- Applicant must obtain a minimum average of 75% or higher in Grade 12.
- Applicant must exhibit high qualities of citizenship, leadership and sportsmanship.
- Applicant must be graduating from Cobequid Educational Centre.
- Applicant must provide an official transcript of high school grades and two letters of reference (academic and character).
- Applicant must give indication of anticipated costs of first year University or Community College and level of financial support available from other sources such as employment, scholarships and bursaries.
