
CONDITIONS OF BURSARY:

- 1. Value of Bursary
- 1,500.
- 2. One or more bursaries aggregating \$1,500 will be awarded annually as an entrance bursary to a student or students entering university or community college directly from high school.
- 3. Applicant must be a Canadian citizen and resident of Colchester County, Nova Scotia, or any municipal unit therein.
- 4. Applicant must be seeking admission to a degree granting university/college in one of the four Atlantic Provinces or a community college in Nova Scotia.

ELIGIBILITY FOR BURSARY:

- 1. Applicant must be intending to undertake full-time, first year studies.
- 2. Applicant must obtain a minimum average of 75% or higher in Grade 12.
- 3. Applicant must exhibit high qualities of citizenship, leadership and sportsmanship.
- 4. Applicant must be graduating from the Cobequid Educational Centre (CEC).
- 5. Applicant must provide an official transcript of high school grades and two letters of reference (academic and character).
- 6. Applicant must give indication of anticipated costs of first year university/ community college and level of financial support available from other sources (eg. employment, scholarships, bursaries, family).
