

## The Nova Scotia Strong Flower Fund Bursary





## (In memory of Victorian Order of Nurses employees CCA Kristen Beaton and LPN Heather O'Brien)

James Grant along with his wife Tanya (a Licensed Practical Nurse, and an employee of VON for a number of years) and their 11-year-old daughter Abbi, started making the flowers to resemble the Nova Scotia flag, to honour the people of Colchester County. What started out as a small project in their workshop in Milton, Queens County, NS grew to a staggering 1500 orders in just a few weeks. They received orders from almost every Canadian province and even one order from Italy. They decided to put five dollars for every flower sold into a Bursary Fund to honour VON employees, CCA Kristen Beaton and LPN Heather O'Brien. Even though the Grants both have full time jobs, no matter how many orders come in, they plan to continue to make them until every last order is filled! Their hope is that they will be able to offer this bursary for some years to come!

There will be 2 bursaries awarded, valued at \$500 each.

## Criteria:

- 1. Must be a grade 12 student who is graduating in June 2020 from a high school in Colchester County.
- 2. Student has applied to and been accepted into a full-time program at a post-secondary institution in September 2020 or January 2021 in an accredited CCA program or an accredited LPN program.
- 3. Volunteerism may be considered.
- 4. A complete application must be received by the Nova Scotia Strong Flower Fund Bursary organizers by the deadline date stated.

The Bursary amount will be forwarded to the post-secondary institution the student is attending once the recipient has emailed proof of registration to the Bursary committee.
