
Grade 11 and 12 Registration opens

PREPARATION FOR REGISTRATION

- ▶ Complete the worksheet and credit check sheet received in class
- ▶ Refer to pages 7 and 8 in the course selection guide for information about courses required to graduate
- ▶ Grade 11 students **MUST** have a minimum of 6 and maximum of 8 courses
- ▶ Grade 12 students just need to take the courses they need to fulfill graduation requirements.
- ▶ ***Anyone wishing to participate in extra-curricular activities must take a minimum of 3 courses per semester.**
- ▶ If you are going in to grade 12 and plan to finish all graduation requirements in Semester 1, please let Morgan in Student Services know before **March 29th**, we will try to make the courses fit.

Welcome to the Cobequid Educational Centre Class Registration System for 2022-2023

The Registration Portal is open for ALL Grade 11 Students, until March 29th, 2022. Grade 11's must select a minimum of 6 courses and a maximum of 8. **If 6 courses NOT 8.** Once you have submitted your requests you can continue to edit your choices until March 29th, 2022. **The Deadline for course changes is April 1st, 2022.** Carefully! And use your Registration Worksheet. DO NOT USE Internet Explorer as your Web Browser.

ALL COURSES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE PENDING ENROLMENT NUMBERS. INSUFFICIENT ENROLMENT MAY RESULT IN A COURSE NOT BEING AVAILABLE. STUDENTS' ALTERNATE CHOICES WILL BE SUBSTITUTED. ALTERNATE CHOICES MUST BE DIFFERENT FROM FIRST CHOICES. IF NOT, THE REGISTRATION SYSTEM WILL SELECT A COURSE FOR YOU.

There will be help available in Student Services with a CEC counselor and the Registrar, during lunch hour for students with Registration questions, access issues, or difficulties. Please listen to announcements for further info.

Once you have completed the online registration, you should print a copy of your confirmation sheet. On the copy that you take home, please write beside the course, and the course number.

PLEASE NOTE: Only those students in the O2 program in Grade 10 are permitted to sign up for O2 courses in Grade 11. O2 students must select Co-Op 11 for O2.

STUDENTS REGISTERING FOR IB COURSES- Diploma or Certificate (Full or Partial): If you are an IB course student, please see Ms. Pynn-Crowe in Rm 19 for IB student services during the lunch period to complete your registration. If you are a Full Diploma Student, see Ms. Pynn-Crowe in Room 19, during lunch.

RESOURCE CENTRE/ LEARNING STRATEGIES: If requesting Resource Centre, please go to the Grade 11 Resource Centre and Learning Strategies Section. Students will take German 11 over the school year, and German 12 if you want a second Resource Centre block (for those who want one each Semester, they will take both German 11 and German 12). Next, the bottom of the Special Section Form must be completed by your school's Resource Centre Teacher.

SOCIAL LITERACY 11: Social Literacy 11 is not available for online registration. If your Resource Centre Teacher recommends you for Social Literacy 11, you will select Social Literacy 11 on the Special Section Form, indicating that you want to register for Social Literacy 11 and please indicate the course you would like to drop in its place.







SPECIAL SECTIONS: All Female Physically Active Living 11 and Music 11 Band- you must submit a Special Section Form online.
