

Preparation for Registration

- ▶ Complete the worksheet and credit check sheet received in class
- ▶ Refer to pages 8 and 9 in the course selection guide for information about courses required to graduate
- ▶ Grade 11 students **MUST** have a minimum of 7 and maximum of 8 courses
- ▶ Grade 12 students just need to take the courses they need to fulfill graduation requirements (minimum of 3).
- ▶ ***Anyone wishing to participate in extra-curricular activities must take a minimum of 3 courses per semester.**
- ▶ All students **MUST** choose 2 alternate courses in case your first choice of courses are full or not offered.
- ▶ If you are going in to grade 12 and plan to finish all graduation requirements in Semester 1, please let Morgan in Student Services know before **March 28th**, we will try to make the courses fit.

The Registration Portal is open for ALL Grade 11 Students until March 28th, 2024. Grade 11's must select a minimum of 7 courses and a maximum of 8. **If you only want 7 courses, please choose 7 courses NOT 8.** Once you have submitted your requests you can continue to edit your choices until March 28th, 2024. Please Read ALL Directions Carefully and use your Registration Worksheet to help you. **DO NOT USE Internet Explorer as your Web Browser.**

ALL COURSES ARE SUBJECT TO CHANGE PENDING ENROLMENT NUMBERS. INSUFFICIENT ENROLMENT MAY RESULT IN A COURSE NOT BEING OFFERED. IF THIS OCCURS, STUDENTS' ALTERNATE CHOICES WILL BE SUBSTITUTED. ALTERNATE CHOICES MUST BE DIFFERENT FROM FIRST CHOICES. IF NOT, THE REGISTRAR WILL CHOOSE A COURSE FOR YOU.

There will be help available in Student Services with a CEC counselor and the Registrar, during lunch hour for students with Registration questions, access issues, or difficulties. Please listen to announcements for further info.

PLEASE NOTE:

O2 Students Only those students in the O2 program in Grade 10 are permitted to sign up for O2 courses in Grade 11. O2 students must select Co-Op 11 and Co-Op 12 for O2. Be sure to select COOPO211 and COOPO212.

Co-op 12 Students wishing to take Co-op 12 who are NOT in O2, be sure to select COOP12 under electives. After Registration is complete, please copy and paste this URL into your browser: <http://cecstudentservices.ccrc.ca/index.php/co-operative-education-coop12-information-and-online-application-link/> Print and complete ALL CoOp12 application forms. Return them to Student Services by March 22, 2024. Students must be 16 to take Co-op 12.

SOCIAL LITERACY AND TECHNOLOGY 11: Social Literacy and Technology 11 is not available for online registration. If your Resource Centre Teacher recommends you for Social Literacy and Technology 11, you will select a course online, then complete the Special Section Form, indicating that you want to register for Social Literacy and Technology 11 and please indicate the course you would like to drop in its place.


- You must complete the special section form if you are requesting any of the following courses:
