# Graduation Requirements

•TOTAL OF **18 CREDITS** to earn **High School Diploma**:

- 3 ENGLISH** (one at each grade level)
- 3 MATH** (one at each grade level)
- 2 SCIENCES** (Sci10 + one other approved Science course)
- 1 CANADIAN STUDIES** (MKS11, ACS11,(CHS11) or COCAS11)
- 1 FINE ARTS** (Art, Music, Dance, IFA or Drama)
- 1 PHYS. ED.** (PheAL, Dance , Phys. Ed, Yoga, Martial Arts, Exercise Science, Phys. Ed. Leadership)
- 1 OTHER** from Science or Tech
- 1 GLOBAL STUDIES** (Global Hist 12, Global Politics 12 or Global Geo 12)
- No more than 7 grade 10 credits** towards 18 mandatory
- Minimum 5 grade 12 credits**

# Potential Grad List

- Each fall, the Potential Graduation List will be posted on Student Services website and the Grade 12 Google classroom. Students should check that they are on it and that their legal names are spelled correctly.
- Grad list will be updated during the year.

# IB Courses

- All IB students register with Ms. Pynn-Crowe using paper forms, pick up in student services and return to room 19 from now – March 28, 2024
- Students who are not full IB will need to complete their registration in student services at lunch time. IB courses will not be available for on-line registration.
- Diploma students will be placed in the courses first, and then if there is room, course students will be placed.



# Grade 11 Requirements

- English (ECM, academic, advanced, IB)
- Math (Ess, at work, academic, Pre-Cal, IB)
- Canadian Content (African Canadian Studies 11, Mi'kmaw Studies 11, Contemporary Canadian Studies 11) if you have not satisfied the requirement in grade 10.
- Fine Arts or Phys Ed if needed

# Grade 12 Requirements

- English (ECM, academic, African heritage, advanced, IB)
- Math (Ess, at work, academic, Pre-Cal, Calculus, IB)
- Global Studies (Global Geography, History or Politics)
- Courses to graduate & program entry
- Reminder – Students need a minimum of 5 grade 12 courses to graduate.
